Report from June 1 – July 13, 2001

Just a quick not to everyone to let you know some of the things that have been happening.

- We have received donations in the amount of \$3202.95 and have distributed \$4084.20.
- We sent \$500 down to Rev. Martin Tovar to be used by him and for the mission in San Lorenzo. I believe that I have sent a couple of letters to you from Rev. Martin and Misael Tovar.
- We sent \$500 to the Lutheran Synod of Mexico, which was divided up between the pastors in Mexicali and San Louis Rio Colorado.
- We purchased a Dake Annotated red Letter Edition of the KJV Bible and sent it to New Delhi. The total cost of that was \$235.20.
- We sent \$2770 to the Lutheran Synod of Mexico to pay for the transportation of youth from Mexico City to join the youth from Christ the King of Waxahachie in beginning the project of building a parsonage for the church in Guasave.
- The wire transfers of money cost us an additional \$80.
- Pray for the missions in Chihuahua and for rain in that part of the country.

- KIMA, through the generous gift of Messiah Lutheran in Bullock Creek, Michigan is paying for the housing and meals for Rev. Abiut Fajardo to attend the Synodical convention in St. Louis.
- CAN-DO, KIMA, and the Lutheran Synod of Mexico are joining together to man a booth at the Synodical Convention. The Video “Empty the Darkness” has been completed and will be distributed at the Synodical Convention. Copies of the video will be available free although we hope that we can get the people to pay for the cost of mailing the video. Ron Scherch from CAN-DO is up in St. Louis with our booth right now. Rob Krotzer from Midland, Michigan came down with the videos and will be there till at least Tuesday. Rev. Norm Finke is going up on Tuesday and will stay until Friday and bring back the booth and any extra materials that were not handed out. Rev. Abiut Fajardo, president of the Lutheran Synod of Mexico will also be there and will help out occasionally with the booth.
- Check out the Lutheran Witness for a special report in the July and August issue. CAN-DO is giving KIMA it’s spot for those two months. The Lutheran Synod of Mexico is being featured.
- We are in the process of gathering money to help pay for youth from Rio Bravo to attend the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans. We need a little over four hundred for housing and then enough to pay for meals for three people for the entire event. Cross of Christ VBS in DeSoto has been working on this. Lori Bachman is trying to coordinate it from Brownsville.
- Often times special projects come up that we can help with. Most of the time they are projects that we have not planned on. The two projects involving the youth of the Synod were two of those projects. We felt that they were important in that they began to involve youth in ministry. We have had to borrow from Peter to pay Paul. If there are any groups out there that could help out to cover some of these expenses please keep these projects in mind.
