Next week all the pastors of the Lutheran Synod of Mexico plan to meet at El Sembrador in Monterrey. They will meet to decide what steps they need to take to advance the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Lutheran Synod of Mexico has asked Kima to provide \$4000 in funds to help take care of the expenses for the pastors to attend this Conference. That funding has been forwarded and it is our prayer that they would all arrive safely and come to decisions that will advance the Lord's work in Mexico.

On Sunday, November 16 they will dedicate the new structure that will serve as their church. Above you see to the left the new building and to the right the old building that they presently use to minister to about ten adults and nine children. They do not have a pastor at the moment. Three lay people conduct worship services and Rev. Bill Reagan comes down once a month to serve the Lord's Supper to the communicants.
