One of the tasks that Pastor recommended to me was to take care of this mission, and thanks to God each day there has been new people becoming saved.

We have four families that attend regularly the services, which we have every Sunday at 4:00 p.m.

Initially we begin having services with some songs and later the preaching, and we finished with a general prayer of intercession. Two months ago we started a class for new believers.

I am thankful for the opportunity to serve God in the City of Matamoros Tamaulipas, at the congregation "Santisima Trinidad" where Pastor Isaac Garcia is, and I am also thankful that I can be part of his working team .

When Santisima Trinidad accepted the proposal of the SLMAR that they could support me as Vicar in their congregation, one of the projects was to start new missions. And thanks be to God that in the heart of a member of the congregation was led to lend a property (the one in the pictures).

Originally this place was a seafood restaurant. But long time ago it was closed. Now we use it to worship God and preach His word.

During the month of November we had an Evangelistic Campaign in this place. Since this date we have not stopped having services of Praise and worship to God.

In these classes the objective is that the new believer has the security of his/her salvation and to know the blessings that accompany the faith in Christ. The topic is titled THE GREAT EXCHANGE OF GOD and already almost have finished it.

The sisters that accompany me and my wife from Santísima Trinidad, once per week go to visit the neighbors of this town giving them an invitation that contains the salvation plan, knowing ahead of time that the word of God, doesn't return empty.

The Kids also have their Bible lessons, my sister Aholibama is in charge of the class and before the end of every service they present their lesson before final blessing.
