Isaac Garcia, members of Betania Lutheran Church in Rio Bravo, and Samuel Garcia Marquez began to lay the groundwork for a new mission. They fixed up the building, borrowed money from KIMA to buy a used van, went out onto the streets and lanes to pick up people, had VBS, youth camps, baptisms, and guest speakers.

Four years later Samuel and his wife Alicia, under the Lord's guidance and blessing, head up Bethel Lutheran Mission at Rio Rico. And---- **they are running out of room.**



They just paid off their church van and now they want to add onto the old church to get more space, add two bathrooms and a small office, and generally fix it all up to honor our Lord in heaven.

They have begun working on it pouring some concrete floors, adding some walls and now they have run out of money. They have the workers, the desire to complete the task, a sense of urgency, and they do not want to wait

around when there are souls to be won. Lay-pastor Samuel Garcia estimates that if they had \$1,950.00 they could complete the project.

\$1,950! Sounds like a nice project for some church, or men's, ladies', or youth group.

Wouldn't that be something to be proud of -- the Lord using you to extend His Kingdom in Rio Rico! Maybe you could find another group to join in with you, a good ole zone or circuit activity.
