


3. Remodeling and repairs will be needed to be done to some of the church properties.


4. Instructional and devotional materials

They have requested copies of Portales de Oración, and I'm sure in the near future, the Small Catechism, VBS Material, and Bibles.










5. The funding for Vacation Bible materials for approximately 850 children was \$3,014.63.

We can't all speak the language.


But, if each person does what he/she can, we can put it all together, and join Jesus on His mission in reaching out in love to those who have not yet heard the Good News of God's salvation plan.
