Here, the roof is on and they are working at covering the cement and cement block with stucco. This picture is at the top of the sanctuary. The wood that looks like flooring



is really like a scaffolding on which the men can work on these upper areas. Once that is finished, the wood will be removed, and they can work on the bottom half of the church.

Goal: April 4th, Easter Sunday, worship the Risen Lord in this sanctuary!

1st step: Get the stuccoing finished!

Problem: They need another \$3,269 to pay for material and labor.

Temporary solution: We "borrowed" from money received from the KIMA auction that we had hoped to use to fund a new mission in Veracruz or Tampico. Our prayer is, if it be God's will, some people

would step up and help cover the \$3,300 that we sent them to complete the stuccoing.

2nd step: Preparation.

All the lights will have to be reinstalled. The inside of the sanctuary would have to be cleared of debris and cleaned up, pews returned from storage, altar etc. returned so they could begin to have services.

Additional needs:

There would also be a lack of electricity, doors, windows, floor tiles in the new areas like the office and new bathroom at the back of the church, (earlier, I understood that room to be a nursery, but now I understand that it is a bathroom), the children's room, and a new hallway from the children's room to the balcony. Some tiling will have to be done on the floor of the former sanctuary as it was damaged during the construction. There is still stonework needed for the outside and the front façade. Pastor Isaac thinks that they will have to do this little by little since there is much that is missing. They would like to put up a larger cross on the wall behind the altar and sometime in the future put stained glass windows in the windows that line the sanctuary.

I don't have any idea about how all this affects you, exciting, challenging, or, God forbid, ugh. I pray that you will consider this and how it might lead some children, youth, married couples, or single parents to give it a try and stop by that new church called Betania and see what they have to share.

The Lord gave us all the Great Commission to go and make disciples! The purpose of KIMA is to enable God's people to join forces and provide finances and materials that will help our Christian brothers and sisters in Mexico to reach out to people in their neighborhoods so that they may learn of the love and forgiveness of God so that they also may spend an eternity with Him in heaven.
